Kayak club Zeeburg

Kayak club Zeeburg is located at a unique spot in Amsterdam: in the Eastern harbour area and adjacent to the Amsterdam canals, the Amstel, the open IJsselmeer and the quiet region to the north called Waterland.

As a consequence, the club has access to a large variety of kayak destinations. KV Zeeburg organises tours on a regular basis in the above regions and our members often explore unknown and exciting passages. Above all, KV Zeeburg is a friendly and recreation-oriented club.

KV Zeeburg was founded in 2000 and has continued to grow across the years. The boats are housed in 12 containers located at the Nieuwe Vaart, behind Veemarkt 50-78. In the future we hope to arrange an accommodation with more facilities.

Members of the club are expected to be able to swim. Participation in club activities is a personal responsibility and the club is not liable for possible accidents.

Regular club activities

Regular club activities for members take place on Wednesday evening from 19:00 to 21:00 and Saturday morning from 10:00 to 12:00. On Wednesday we tour through the canals of Amsterdam or via the Oranje-sluizen towards Durgerdam on the IJmeer. On Saturday, you can choose your own pace for a healthy start of the weekend. The kayak season starts in April and ends in October.

Weekend and kayak tours

In the weekends, members of KV Zeeburg are very active. Tours are organised on a regular basis, both for experienced as well as for beginning kayakers. Destinations range from the island Pampus to Broek-in-Waterland and Ouderkerk a/d Amstel. Other destinations include the Westelijke Houthavens via the city canals and Muiden along the IJsselmeer.

During Holidays and long weekends we often leave the city together for a camping tour in other areas such as the Friese Weerribben, the Biesbos, the Vinkeveense and Reeuwijkse plassen and the Ardennen in Belgium.

Open House

Everybody is welcome during KVZ open house at the following dates in 2010: April 17th, May 29th, July 3rd, August 28th from 13.00 to 16.00 hrs. Just come along to meet and chat with club members or try a bit of kayaking.

Kayaks

Kayak Club Zeeburg offers opportunity for members to store their kayaks in one of the containers on our location at the Nieuwe Vaart. You have access to your kayak at any time.

Members that do not own a kayak can use one of the club kayaks, including life-jackets and paddles. These can only be used during the regular activities of the club.

Courses

Every year the club offers a variety of courses. During the course for beginners, participants learn to feel comfortable in a kayak and to move efficiently and safely on the water. The course concludes with a tour through the Amsterdam canals.
